Joanne hands down the volunteering bug Joanne yn pasio'r byg gwirfoddoli i'w phlant

'Serial volunteer' Joanne Yeo has changed the lives of many in her local community, helping to create a safer environment with less fear of crime.

The mother of three from Seaside, Llanelli, was named 2011 Wales Volunteer of the Year in the adult category after her fundraising efforts secured resources to the value of more than £30,000 for local groups.

Secretary of Glanymor and Tyisha Safer Communities, Joanne also helps out in the classroom and playground at Copperworks Infants' School, works with other schools on projects including cyber bullying and road safety, and helps organise the local carnival and Christmas celebrations.

'I've lived in Seaside my whole life and have become a bit of a "serial volunteer"!' she said.

'I wholeheartedly love the work I do and would not be able to do anything without the love and support of my family, from my husband - who is always 100 per cent behind everything I do - to my children, who have caught the volunteering bug from me!'
