



# Landfill Disposals Tax Communities Scheme:

## Nationally Significant Project



Under the above grant scheme, WCVA may award a grant to one nationally significant project per year – with a value of between £50,000 and £250,000, projects may begin April 2019 with an end date of no later than September 2021.

This Nationally Significant Grant seeks to fund a project which will contribute to two or more of the themes for the Landfill Disposals Tax Community Scheme with broad applicability across wider areas of Wales.

Applicants should be able to demonstrate the strategic impact they will make through delivering their proposed project. Projects delivered in partnership are welcomed. Any partnership or collaborative application will be submitted by one lead partner, who, if successful will manage the project and hold the grant agreement with WCVA.

**Applications should be made on the eTender application form – Nationally Significant Grant Round - Landfill Disposals Tax Communities Scheme. The LDTCS – Guidance for Applicants October 2018 document can be downloaded on eTender and from the downloads section on the [Landfill Disposals Tax Community Scheme webpages](#) on WCVA’s website.**

The application form follows the same format as the main LDTCS grant scheme, with some additional questions where applicants are asked to demonstrate the sustainability and wider scale impact of their project’s activity. All applicants should be able to clearly describe why their project and its impact are of national significance.

This is a two-step process, projects will be assessed, presented to the LDTCS Advisory Panel by WCVA and if suitable for funding, applicants will be invited to assessment interview stage.
